




Caring for your neighbours

A new volunteering opportunity has arisen as a result of partnership work between City of York Council and Age UK.

Perhaps you have heard about Snow Wardens voluntary initiative? We are looking for residents who are able to give up some of their time to clear snow when the next bad weather hits us.



Volunteers will be provided with training, high visibility gear, snow clearing kit and grit so that they are able to make a real difference in their neighbourhoods by clearing pavements and footpaths.

In addition to the above volunteers will be provided with Age UK (former Age Concern) FIRST CALL 50+ service information pack. The service is there to help vulnerable people by putting them in touch with the services they need to remain safe and independent at home. As a volunteer you will be encouraged to signpost residents to Age UK, who will then assess and provide help needed.

We have 64 participants already and looking at doubling that number.
